The conclusions and recommendations for several sites will be reevaluated based on the results of the groundwater modeling, four quarters of groundwater sampling, total petroleum hydrocarbon toxicity testing, and the additional sampling conducted during September 1996 at Sites 12 and 17. This information will be included in the Draft Final RI Report.
