Dear Ms. Cassa:

The Navy has completed the Draft Final Onshore Remedial Investigation (RI) Report (Tetra Tech, September 1997) for Naval Station Treasure Island. The report has identified installation restoration (IR) Site 05 (Old Boiler Plant) to be impacted only by petroleum. The report also recommended Site 05 to be cleaned up under the Navy's UST program.

Based on the BCT/RPM discussions and our phone conversation last week, the Navy request your concurrence on the transfer of IR Site 05 out of the CERCLA program into the Navy's petroleum program. Site 05 will not proceed to the feasibility studies (FS) phase but will be included in the draft Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for petroleum sites which is due next month.

Again, the Navy would like to assure the regulatory agencies that the transfer will not affect the environmental cleanup and early transfer of NAVSTA TI. The petroleum site cleanup will remain under the purview of the Navy BRAC Environmental Coordinator (BEC) and the BCT.
