During the development of the Site 21 Land Use Control Remedial Design it came to my attention that there is an error in the text. On page 28, the third sentence of the second bullet point states "The deed notice will also require the property owner to notify DTSC of improvements in this area that result in the area being fully enclosed." The problem with this statement is that the purpose of a deed notice is to notify the transferee, not to impose requirements. The Navy is therefore striking the word "notice" from this sentence. A replacement page for your hard copy and a replacement CD are provided for your records.

The Navy does not believe that this change has an effect on the execution or protectiveness of the chosen remedy for Site 21 and the change more adequately reflects the signatories' intentions for remedy implementation.
