The tasks may include, but not limited to: irrigation, drainage, earthmoving, excavating, grading, trenching, paving and resurfacing, carpentry, concrete work, electrical, HVAC, landscaping, masonry, painting/waterproofing, trucking and hauling, welding, and general engineering.
