FORMER NAVAL STATION TREASURE ISLAND, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA –  
NO FURTHER ACTION FOR WASTEWATER LINES DOWNSTREAM FROM  
FORMER BUILDING 233

Dear Mr. Forman:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control and the California Department Public Health (CDPH) have reviewed the *Final Report, Scoping Survey of Wastewater Lines Downstream from Former Building 233, Former Naval Station Treasure Island, San Francisco, California* (Final Report) dated June 24, 2016. DTSC and CDPH provided comments on the draft of this Report on February 6, 2016. Navy responses were provided in the Responses to Comments (RTC) dated June 6, 2016. The RTC was revised based on follow up comments from CDPH. The revised RTC was included as Appendix F of the Final Report.


The site covered by the Final Report includes the waste water lines downstream from former Building 233 located at the southeast section of the former Naval Station Treasure Island (NSTI). The site was classified as radiologically impacted in the 2014 Historical Radiological Assessment Technical Memorandum prepared for NSTI due to the Radium-226 spill at the former Building 233 in the 1950s.

As presented in the Final Report, the results of the scoping surveys were below the radiological screening criteria, and no evidence of radiological contamination was observed at the site. Therefore, the Final Report recommended no further action (NFA). Per the enclosed August 31, 2016 email, CDPH has no further comments on the Final Report. Therefore, DTSC concurs with the NFA recommendation for the site.
