

UNDERWATER WORK- UXO 16 EXPANDED SITE INSPECTION (ESI)

UXO 16 ESI Location



- Offshore area next to SWMU 4
- Where munitions from historic open burning/open detonation (OB/OD) may be present
 - Ejected from OB/OD pits directly into water
 - Washed off land into water
- •20 mm projectiles primarily identified on land



UXO 16 ESI Objectives and Approach




Objectives

- Determine if munitions are present in the water adjacent to SWMU 4
- Use findings to determine need for further investigation or action

General Approach


- Divers with metal detectors search for munitions throughout area



UXO 16 ESI Detailed Approach



- Divide area into zones based on potential for munitions to be present
 - Higher coverage in areas with higher potential for munitions to be present
 - -Search for munitions is done along "transects" approximately 6 feet wide
- Two types of divers
 - Munitions divers specifically trained to search for and remove underwater munitions
 - Scientific divers (biologists) to ensure sensitive marine species and habitats are protected



UXO 16 ESI Status



- •Began March 30, 2015
- Anticipated to be complete by end of May
 - -Equivalent to over 90,000 feet of transects









- Trash (such as soda cans) primarily identified
- •Only a few munitions items identified (20-mm projectiles, flare), mainly near shore
- All items are significantly deteriorated

Locations are marked by GPS and each item recovered



SWMU 4 NON-TIME CRITICAL INTERIM REMOVAL ACTION

Non-Time Critical Interim Removal Action (NTCRA) Objectives



- Reduce potential explosive hazard associated with areas intended for public use
- Facilitate accelerated public access

Munitions Removal to Support Planned Land Use



Historical Munitions Removal Activities


- -Roads and beach
 - Roads planned for use as hiking, biking, and bird watching trails
- Around former OB/OD pits where amount of munitions was highest

Current Munitions Removal Activities

- -Planned parking and picnic areas
- Planned observation tower
- -Perimeter of lagoon where land crabbing occurs
- -Former OB/OD pits
- -"Spokes" to help determine extent of kick out from OB/OD



- Installation of signs and educational kiosks (pending USFWS plan to open area)




Status of Sites and Upcoming Activities at West Vieques

Proposed Meeting Scheduling Changes



•To enhance the effectiveness of meeting scheduling, we propose:

- 1. Schedule meetings for the whole year. For example: the 2nd or 3rd Wednesday in Feb, May, Aug, and Nov.
- 2. Navy sends a "Save the Date" email to RAB members approximately 6 weeks before each scheduled meeting to facilitate planning.
