



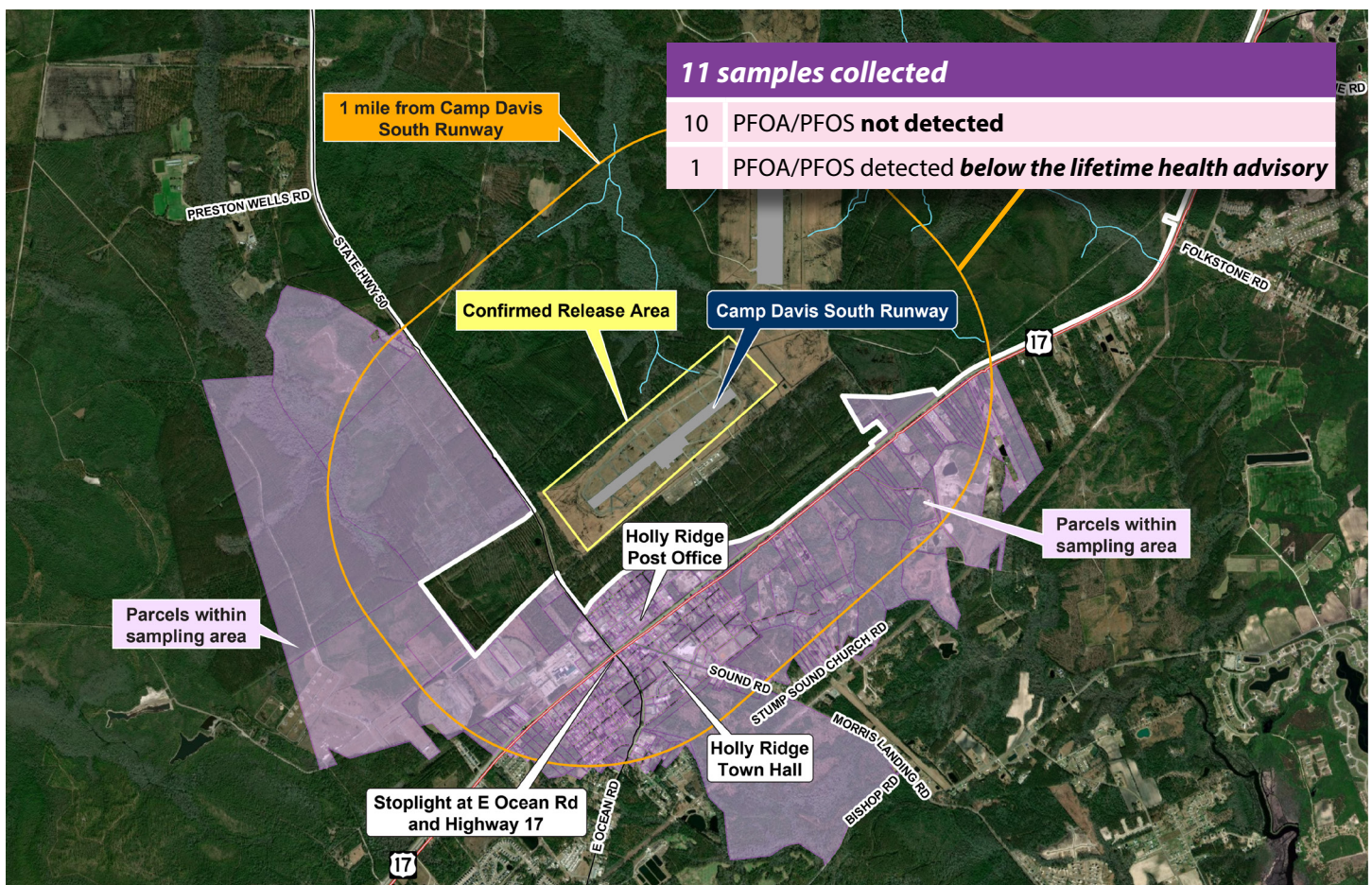
PFAS Drinking Water Sampling near Marine Corps Outlying Landing Field Camp Davis Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune | Holly Ridge, North Carolina



The Department of the Navy and Marine Corps sampled drinking water wells in a designated area near Marine Corps Outlying Landing Field Camp Davis beginning in March 2021. We tested for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), specifically perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), which may be present in these private drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of certain firefighting foams.

Eleven wells were tested, and none had PFOA or PFOS detected above the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency lifetime health advisory. The off-base sampling area does not need to be resampled or expanded at this time based on available information.

Our records indicate that you are a resident and/or property owner in the sampling area.
