



OFF-BASE DRINKING WATER SAMPLING NEAR MARINE CORPS OUTLYING LANDING FIELD ATLANTIC



The Navy and Marine Corps are conducting drinking water well sampling near Marine Corps Outlying Landing Field (MCOLF) Atlantic beginning in May 2025. The sampling is for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in drinking water wells due to past use of firefighting foam or other PFAS-containing materials on the field. Our records indicate the drinking water consumed at this property may come from a well.

This property may be a rental. A separate notification letter asking permission to sample the drinking water well on this property has been sent to the property owner. No action is required on your part to schedule sampling. This sampling would be at no cost to you or the property owner.

We invite you to attend an open house on May 22, 2025, any time between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Atlantic Elementary School gymnasium, 151 School Drive, Atlantic, NC 28511. We will have informational displays about this sampling along with representatives from the Navy, Marine Corps, and North Carolina state agencies available to answer questions you may have.
