

Naval Support Activity (NSA) Cutler Fire Station Cutler, Maine PFAS Drinking Water Investigation


The Navy is conducting a private drinking water well investigation in a designated sampling area near Naval Support Activity (NSA) Cutler Fire Station beginning in September 2020. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in private drinking water wells near NSA Cutler Fire Station due to past uses of certain types of firefighting foam, specifically aqueous film forming foam (AFFF).

Our records indicate that your drinking water may be provided by a private drinking water well located within our designated sampling area. The Navy has requested permission from the property owner to sample private drinking water wells as part of our investigation. If you are the property owner receiving this postcard at a second residence, please note that the Navy also mailed a letter requesting sampling of this property to your address of record for tax billing.

We are committed to keeping the public informed of the Navy's investigation. Ordinarily an Open House public meeting would be held to explain the private well investigation and provide general information on PFAS. However, due to COVID-19 issues, the Navy and our partnering agencies agree that holding a public meeting is not feasible at this time.
