OPEN HOUSE to discuss the ongoing
**PFAS Investigation and Response at
Naval Auxiliary Landing Field Fentress**

The Navy prepared an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) report to evaluate alternatives to address perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and/or perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) above the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's lifetime health advisory level in drinking water on-base and at off-base properties. Based on evaluation of the effectiveness, implementability, and the cost of the alternatives, the Connect to City of Chesapeake Water System is the recommended alternative in the Draft Final EE/CA, which is now available for public comment prior to finalization.
