The Navy is conducting an ongoing private drinking water well investigation in a designated sampling area near Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these private drinking water wells due to past uses of on-base fire-fighting foam, specifically aqueous film forming foam (AFFF).

Although your property is located in the designated sampling area, we will not need to sample your drinking water; we believe your property uses municipal drinking water provided by the City of Virginia Beach and no private drinking water wells are present on your property. **If our records are incorrect, and you have a private drinking water well on your property, the Navy would like permission to sample your private drinking water at no cost to you.**
