



OFF-BASE DRINKING WATER WELL SAMPLING NEAR ST. JULIENS CREEK ANNEX

The Navy is conducting drinking water well sampling near St. Juliens Creek Annex beginning in February 2024. The sampling is for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past use of firefighting foam or other PFAS-containing materials on base.

Your property is not located within the sampling area so the Navy is not asking to sample your drinking water well at this time. Some properties close to yours may be located within the sampling area. The Navy is inviting you to attend an Open House:
