

OFF-BASE DRINKING WATER WELL SAMPLING NEAR ST. JULIENS CREEK ANNEX

The Navy is conducting drinking water well sampling near St. Juliens Creek Annex beginning in February 2024. The sampling is for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past use of firefighting foam or other PFAS-containing materials on base. Although your property is within the sampling area, we do not need to sample your drinking water well. We believe your property either uses public drinking water or does not have a drinking water well.

If our records are incorrect, and you have a drinking water well on your property, the Navy would like permission to sample your drinking water well at no cost to you. You may schedule a drinking water well sampling appointment by leaving a message at **844-844-SJCA (844-844-7522)** with your name, property address, and telephone number.
