



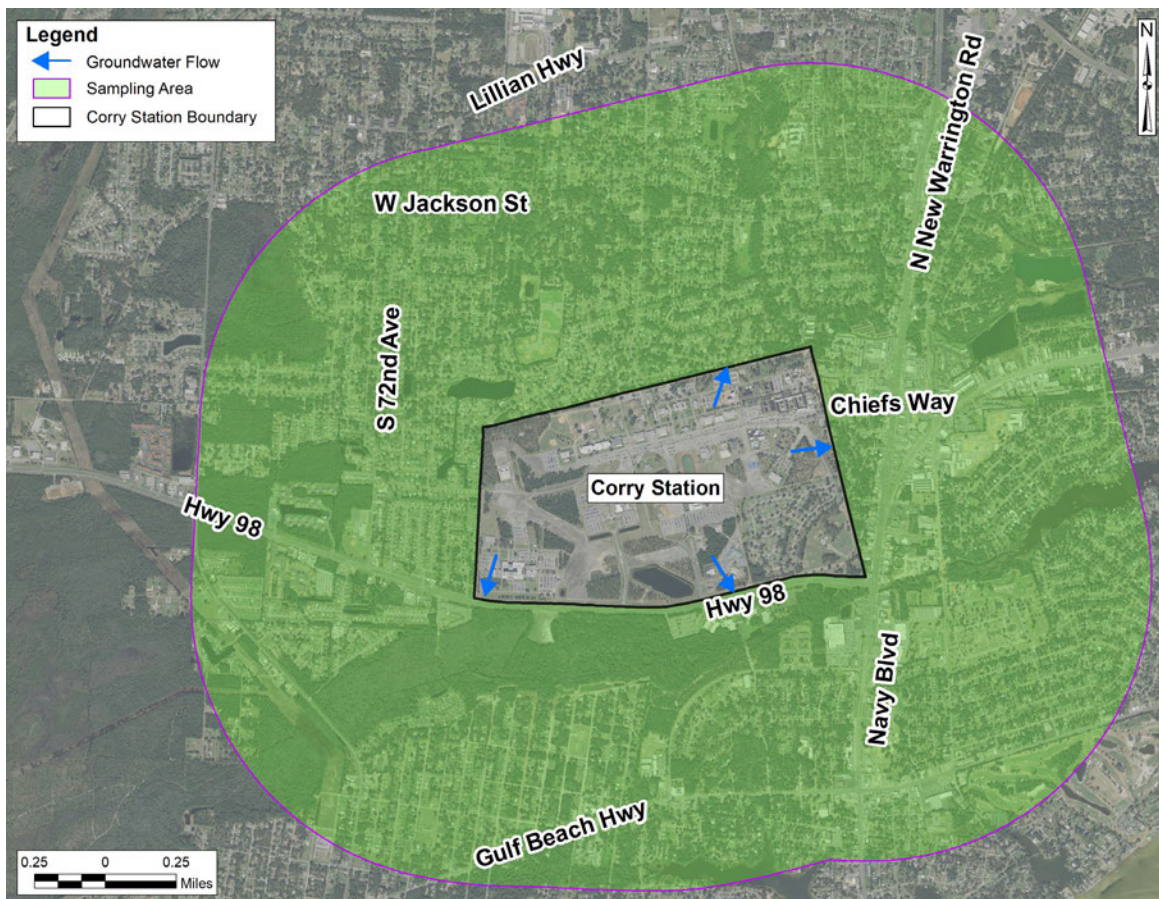
Off-Base Drinking Water Investigation near Corry Station, Pensacola, Florida

The Navy is conducting a drinking water well investigation near Corry Station beginning in January 2022. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of firefighting foam, specifically aqueous film forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials. Your property is in the sampling area, but we believe your property uses public drinking water provided by ECUA or Peoples Water Service Company, and no private drinking water wells are present on your property.

If our records are incorrect, and you have a private well on your property that you use for drinking water, the Navy would like to sample your private drinking water at no cost to you. You may schedule a sampling appointment by calling [REDACTED]; please leave a message with your name, property address, and telephone number.
