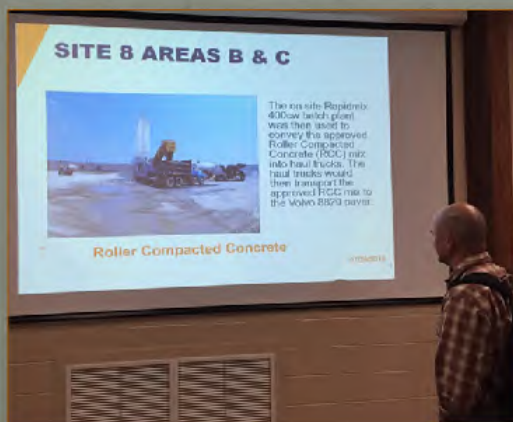
Meeting Format and Content
