

Off-Base Drinking Water Investigation near Naval Air Station Whiting Field

The Navy is conducting a drinking water well investigation in the current designated sampling area near Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field beginning in February 2021. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses onbase of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials. Although your property is within the designated sampling area, we will not need to sample your drinking water. We believe your property uses public drinking water, and no drinking water wells are present on your property.

If our records are incorrect, and you have a drinking water well on your property, the Navy would like permission to sample your drinking water at no cost to you. You may schedule a drinking water well sampling appointment by telephone at 844-NASWFLD (844-627-9353) and leaving a message with your name, property address, property number (if known), and telephone number.
