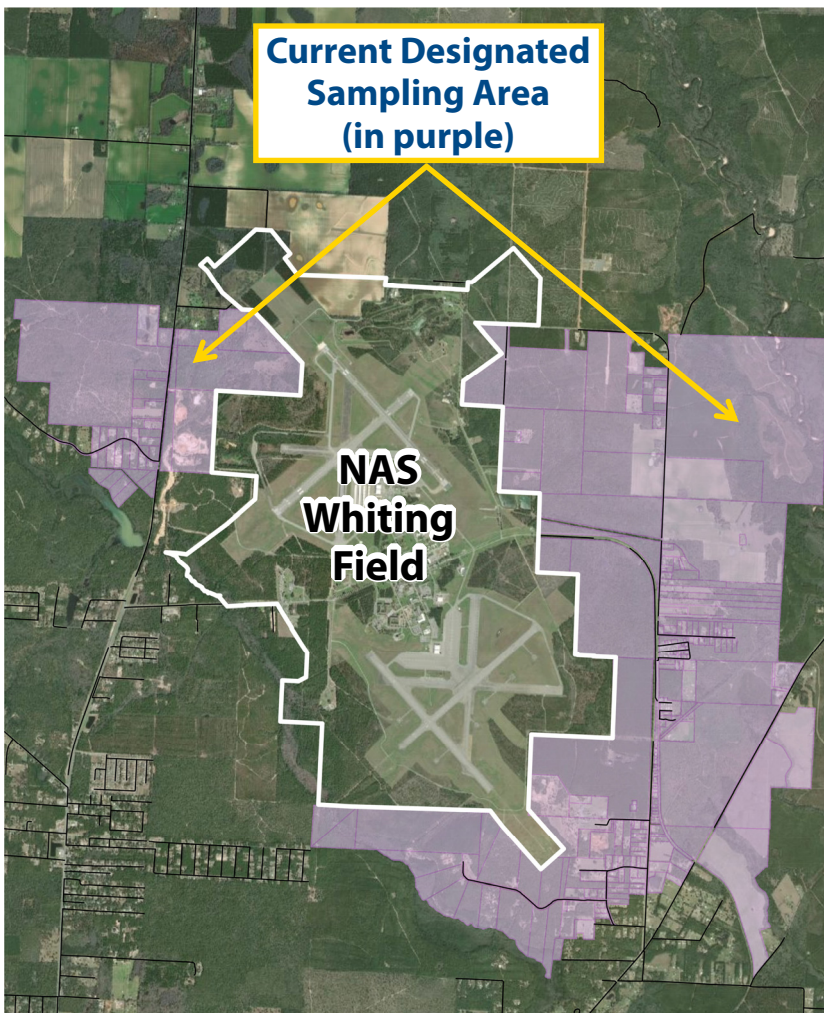




Off-Base Drinking Water Investigation near Naval Air Station Whiting Field

The Navy is conducting a drinking water well investigation near Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field beginning in February 2021. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials. A new sampling area has been designated because of additional findings of AFFF use at NAS Whiting Field. The current designated sampling area does not include the properties sampled in 2017. You are receiving this postcard because your property was sampled in 2017. No action is required on your part at this time.
