


Off-Base Drinking Water Investigation near Naval Air Station Whiting Field

The Navy continues to test drinking water wells for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials. In March 2021, the Navy sampled private drinking water wells near Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field. Based on the initial sampling results, the Navy is expanding this investigation beginning in April 2021. We believe the drinking water consumed on the property you rent may come from a well.

A separate notification letter asking permission to sample the drinking water on this property has been sent to the owner, and no action is required on your part. This sampling would be at no cost to you or the owner.
