SUBJECT: PRIVATE DRINKING WATER WELL SAMPLING NEAR NAVAL AIR STATION WHITING FIELD

The Navy is conducting private drinking water well sampling near Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field beginning in August 2026. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses of a firefighting agent called aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials at NAS Whiting Field. Although this issue is not unique to the Department of War or the Navy, we are conducting this sampling to address possible issues that may exist from past Navy activities.

Your property is located within the sampling area near NAS Whiting Field and based on our records review, we believe the drinking water consumed on your property [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED], may come from a well. If this is the case, we would like permission to sample your drinking water well. You may schedule an appointment by leaving a message at 844-NASWFLD (844-627-9353) with your name, property address, property number (included above), and telephone number. This sampling would be at no cost to you. The enclosed fact sheet (Enclosure 1) provides more information about the Navy's drinking water well sampling near NAS Whiting Field.

The Navy is conducting this private drinking water well sampling near NAS Whiting Field in partnership with the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and the Florida Department of Health. If PFAS are found in your drinking water well at levels requiring action (Enclosure 1), the Navy will provide an enduring solution, such as connection to public water or installation of a treatment system. Additionally, the Navy will provide bottled water for drinking and cooking to any property owner or tenant in the sampling area whose drinking water well contains perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and/or perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS), individually or combined, above 70 parts per trillion, and will continue to provide bottled water until an enduring solution is implemented.

The Navy will also be hosting an in-person open house event at a later date. This will provide you with an opportunity to ask the various subject matter experts involved in the Navy's response any additional questions you may have.

Please complete and return the drinking water well questionnaire (Enclosure 2) and Right of Entry agreement form (Enclosure 3) prior to your sampling appointment.
