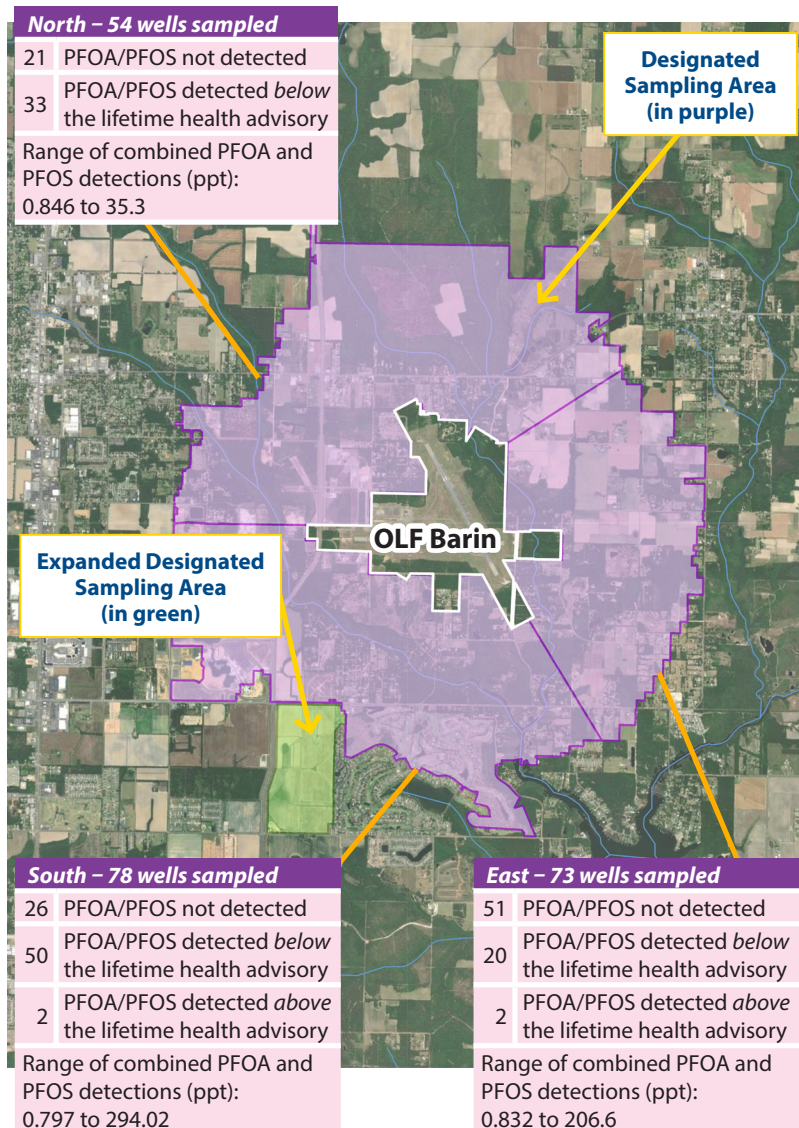




Drinking Water Investigation near Outlying Landing Field Barin

The Navy began a drinking water well investigation near Outlying Landing Field (OLF) Barin, an OLF for Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field, in June 2021. The Navy tested for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), specifically perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials.



Based on the initial sampling results, the Navy is expanding the sampling area beginning in November 2021. We believe the drinking water consumed on the property you rent may come from a well.

A separate notification letter asking permission to sample the drinking water on this property has been sent to the owner, and no action is required on your part. This sampling would be at no cost to you or the owner.
