

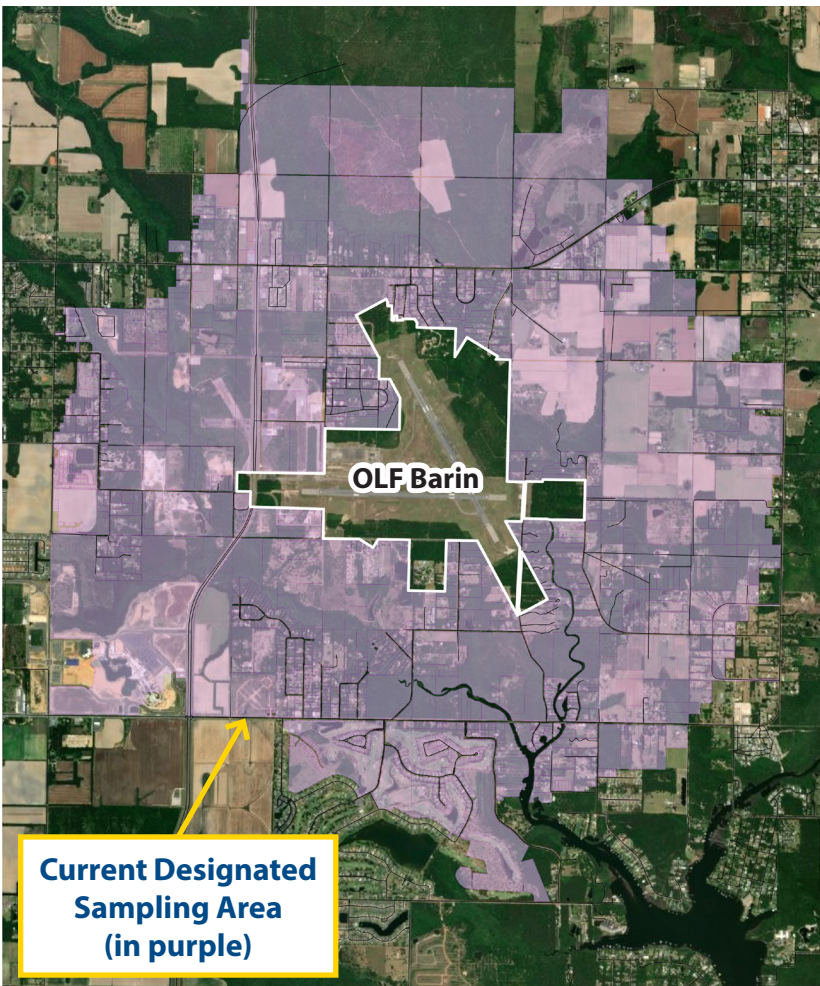


Drinking Water Investigation near Outlying Landing Field Barin

The Navy is conducting a drinking water well investigation in the current designated sampling area near Outlying Landing Field (OLF) Barin, an OLF for Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field, beginning in June 2021. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials. We believe the drinking water consumed on the property you rent may come from a well.

A separate notification letter asking permission to sample the drinking water on this property has been sent to the owner, and no action is required on your part.

This sampling would be at no cost to you or the owner.
