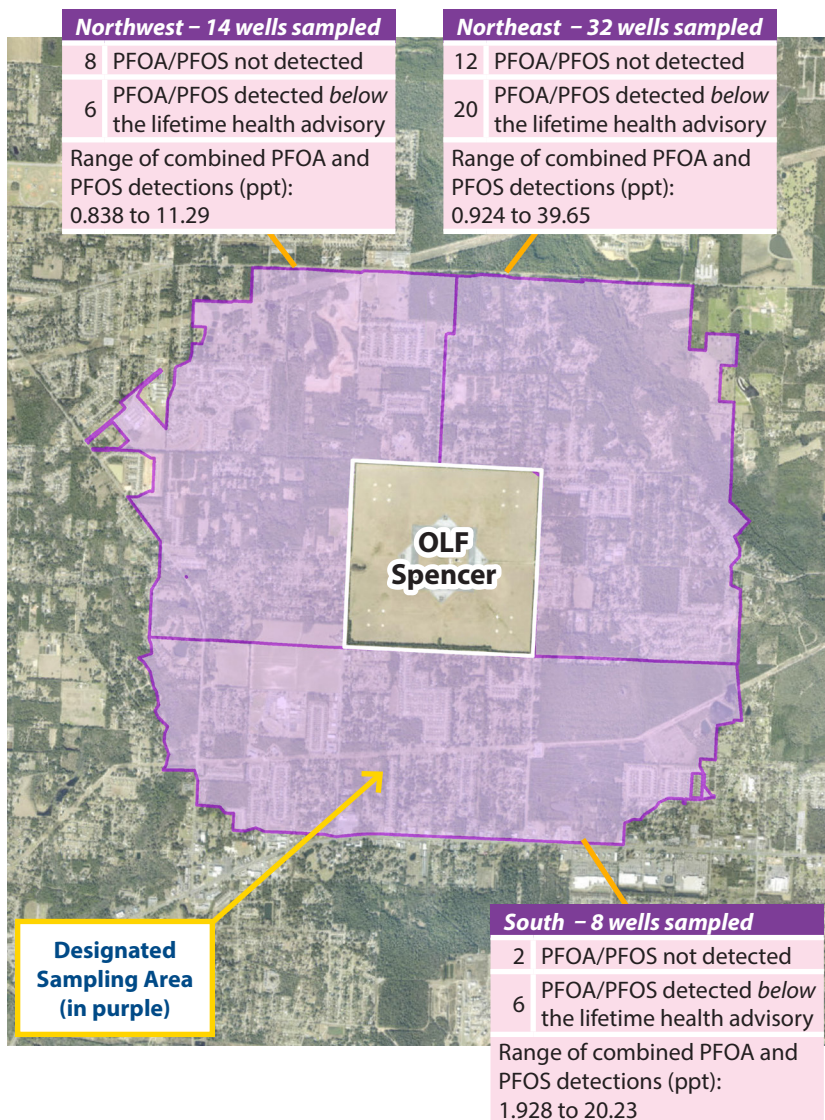




# Drinking Water Investigation near Outlying Landing Field Spencer

The Navy began a drinking water well investigation near Outlying Landing Field (OLF) Spencer, an OLF for Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field, in June 2021. The Navy tested for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), specifically perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past uses on-base of aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), or other PFAS-containing materials.



PFOA and PFOS were not detected above the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency lifetime health advisory of 70 parts per trillion (ppt) in any of the wells sampled.
