

RESPONSIBILITY ASSIGNMENT MATRIX (RACI MATRIX)

A responsibility assignment chart that maps out every task, milestone or key decision involved in completing a project and assigns which roles are **Responsible** for each action item, which personnel are **Accountable**, and, where appropriate, who needs to be **Consulted** or **Informed**

RESPONSIBLE

- The person actually carries out the process or task assignment
- Responsible to get the job done

ACCOUNTABLE

- The person who is ultimately accountable for the process or task being completed appropriately
- Responsible person(s) are accountable to this person

CONSULTED

- People who are not directly involved with carrying out the task but are consulted
- May be stakeholder or subject matter expert

INFORMED

 Those who receive output from the process or task, or who have a need to stay informed

- Allocate only one person as accountable per assignment
- Make sure that those who are assigned as accountable have all authorizations to execute the assignment
- Keep everyone informed of any changes
- Ensure everyone understands their roles and their colleagues' roles
