

# TIPS FOR EFFECTIVE COACHING QUESTIONS


## **KEEP THE QUESTIONS...**

#### 1. OPEN ENDED

- Avoid starting questions with Will you...? Did you...? Have you...?
- Start questions with: what, who, and how


#### 2. SHORT


- Avoid asking magnificently complex, compound questions
- Ask short questions that are less than 8 words, such as: What does success look like?, What's the objective?, What's the impact?



### 3. ADVICE FREE

- Avoid phrases such as: Why don't you...? Have you tried...? What if you...?
- Ask questions that invite the coachee to self-advise





#### 4. FORWARD FOCUSED

- Avoid the "he-said-she-said" and the "what happened-next" conversations of the past
- Use forward-based language, such as:
   What will you do next week? In six months? In two years?

#### 5. THOUGHT PROVOKING

- Thought provoking questions literally cause people to stop in their tracks
- Ask thought provoking questions, such as:
   How will you know you've achieved your goal?,
   What is your role in that situation?, Where can you take responsibility?
