NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLAN AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD For Groundwater Remedial Action at Sites 1 and 2 Former Marine Corps Air Station El Toro

The U.S. Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, encourages the public to comment on the Proposed Plan for former Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro groundwater remedies at Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Sites 1 and 2, located in Irvine, California. The Proposed Plan presents the preferred alternatives for cleanup of groundwater associated with IRP Sites 1 and 2. The Proposed Plan also provides a summary of investigations and evaluations, risk assessments, and remedial alternatives.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Proposed Plan during the 30-day public comment period, held from April 20 through May 20, 2011. Written or oral comments may be provided during the public meeting on April 27, 2011; other public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or e-mailed no later than May 20, 2011.
