SWMU 4

The Phase III of the site investigation is scheduled to start on December 2, 2002. The duration of this field event is approximately 2 months. The CH2M HILL personnel involved in this effort are Gary Webb and Fernando Ferreira. The subcontractors will be USA Environmental, NAEVA Geophysics, and Timberline Environmental Services.

AOC E

The modification to the contract order is expected for October, 2002. When the funding is received, the RI/FS report will be prepared and the risk assessment will be conducted. The draft report is scheduled for the end of December, 2002.

Phase II PA/SI Report

The Final Phase II PA/SI Report is expected to be completed at the end of October, 2002.

Background Report for NASD

The Final Background Report for NASD is expected to be completed at the end of October, 2002.

Draft NFA for NASD

The AOC R site will not be included in the NFA Report. A separate investigation for this site will include an RI/FS. The following sites are included in the NFA Report:

- AOC-K Former Water Well
- AOC-L Septic Tank
