The munitions removal process continues reducing the explosives risk

As of August 1, 2008

- 770 acres in the LIA and ECA have been surface cleared. Over 13,000 live munitions removed.
- All beaches (65 acres) have previously been surface cleared
- Approximately 4,900 tons of munitions debris (MD) and range related debris (RRD) has been recovered and is being processed for eventual shipment to a recycler.
- Over 1,700 tons of MD and RRD have been shipped off island to be recycled.
