Summary of all Removal Actions on East Vieques



To reduce the explosive risk, munitions removal actions are being conducted in all accessible areas within the Live Impact Area (LIA) and the Surface Impact Area (SIA)

- Surface removal is 68% complete, 1,566 acres have been surface cleared in the ECA, LIA and SIA
- Sub- surface removal of MEC at beaches and roads is 27% completed
- 34,642 munitions items have been recovered and destroyed.
- 15.7 million pounds of metal debris have been recovered
- 13.2 million pounds of metal debris have been recycled

Please stay away from all the areas of the former Navy range and its surrounding waters until all investigations have been completed. Those who trespass expose themselves to grave danger. Please observe the warning signs.
