Munitions Response Program Update

- The munitions response operations continue with the surface clearance of munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) within the eastern part of the Surface Impact Area (SIA).
- Subsurface clearance of munitions is being conducted at the roads along the north end of the Eastern Maneuver Area (EMA), and Yellow Beach buffer zone.
- Navy contractors conducted monitoring of sea turtle nesting areas in the SIA and EMA to prepare for subsurface clearance of MEC.
