PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project includes the demolition of 8 elevated storage tanks at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and the construction of 7 new elevated storage tanks to replace the demolished tanks. The new elevated storage tanks will consist of a mix of composite tanks, steel fluted tanks, and a hydropillar style tank. The tanks will range in size from 100,000 gallons to 750,000 gallons. This project will require special coordination and phasing in order to keep the existing water system in service during construction and demolition of the elevated water storage tanks. Also included with this project is construction of water mains to service the new tanks and associated site work at each tank site.
