PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Design-bid-build project to construct a 109,000 square foot multi-story addition to the Naval Hospital. The addition will house primary, urgent, and emergency care, pharmacy, and patient administration functions. The scope of work also includes another addition of a 6,700 square foot MRI area and the renovation of 162,000 square feet of existing space in the Naval Hospital. The additions will be constructed of structural steel framing, reinforced Concrete Masonry Unit (CMU) walls with brick veneer, and flat built-up roofs. Site improvements include new roadways, paved parking and drainage system. This project will improve patient access to care and efficiency of hospital operations due to current deficiencies in departmental adjacencies, layout, and patient/staff circulation.
