This is a US Navy funded Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA), following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

The Navy's contractor will be working Monday through Thursday only.

**Summary of Activities:**

**Work Accomplished**

- Completed the remediation and scanning of the common wall inside Building 27 South Shed.
- Continued the replacement of storm line and catch basins at CB-5 to MH137.
- Installed temporary roofing patch on Building 27 South Shed.
- Continue the remediation and scanning in Building 27 Stair Towers.
- Completed weekly security inspections and RMA boundary surveys/sampling.
- Completed weekly Tisch filter collection/change-out.

**Activities Planned for Next Week:**

- Backfill Trench Survey Units 10 and install storm drain and catch basins west of Bldg. 27.
- Pending data Review - Backfill Trench Survey Unit 11 east of Bldg. 2.
- Pending Seattle City Light electrical work – complete the removal of the electrical panels, excavation of Hot Spot 9 and removal of the remaining storm drain line under the panels.
- Continue remediation and scanning in Building 27 Stair Towers.
- Remove Building 27 penthouse on south shed roof pending fire suppression line disconnection and asbestos abatement.
- Mobilization of tanks, fencing, and equipment in preparation of storm line cleaning.

**Status of Schedule:**

- Expected TCRA completion - Fall 2014
