**US Navy Cleanup Project**

This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

The Navy's contractor will be working Monday through Thursday only.

**For the Period:** September 24, 2013                      **Through:** September 30, 2013  
**Date of Report:** October 1, 2013

**Summary of Activities:**

- Completed removal, packaging and RMA storage of 87 square meters of contaminated wood flooring from second floor of Building 2. (Top layer of 2 layer system). Total to date: 120 square meters.
- Completed containerization of vegetation collected in outside area of building 27.
- Completed Video Camera Inspection of catch basins and associated drainage system in outside area adjacent to Building 27.
- Completed incoming surveys of equipment; dewatering boxes, steel roadway plates, dewatering pump, and associated hoses and fittings.
- Completed weekly/monthly RMA boundary surveys and sampling.
- Completed weekly air sampler filter collection/change-out.
- Start removing, packaging and RMA storage of partition wall and miscellaneous pieces of contaminated wood flooring (under walls) from Building 2 (62 LF of wall to date)

**Activities Planned for Next Week:**

- Continue with partition wall/miscellaneous wood flooring removal Building 2.
- Complete set-up for soil removal in outside area adjacent to Building 27 (bins/ground protection/dewatering equipment).
- Begin soil removal along south face of Building 27 (weather dependent).
- Complete mapping of exterior gamma walkover surveys in potential soil contamination areas identified in the Remedial Investigation and forward data to the Navy.

**Status of Schedule:**

- On time.
