This is a US Navy funded Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA), following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

Summary of Activities:

Work Accomplished

- Collected gamma bias statics in Building 27 stair towers.
- Demobilized fork lift, excavator, and steel plates.
- Began the scanning/sampling of the Building 27 attic space and penthouse.
- Conducted walk around of Building 2 to identify security gaps.
- Down posted portions of SU 1 and 2 of Building 2 and gave access to the city's restoration contractor to repair dry-rotted floor/wall. Partitions were installed to keep restoration workers from other Building 2 Survey Units.
- Conducted remediation of the Building 27 penthouse
- Site housekeeping/BMPs.
- Completed weekly security inspections and RMA boundary surveys/sampling.
- Completed weekly Tisch filter collection/change-out.

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Complete the scanning/sampling of the penthouse of Building 27

- Expected TCRA completion - Fall 2014
