**US Navy Cleanup Project**

This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

The Navy's contractor will be working Monday through Thursday only.

**Date of Report:** September 3, 2013

**Summary of Activities:**

- Completed background reference surveys in Building 47 for gas proportional instruments.
- Completed Building 2 reacquisition surveys of hotspots identified in the RI Report.
- Collected and shipped soil samples of import fill materials (topsoil and common borrow) to laboratories for chemical and radiological analysis.
- Completed remaining section of temporary drainage system at Building 27
- Completed gamma walkover surveys of outside area adjacent to Building 27, except at steel plate covered hotspots in narrow grassy strip west of building.
- Completed weekly/monthly RMA boundary survey.
- Completed weekly Tisch air filter collection.

**Activities Planned for Next Week:**

- Begin Building 27 interior reacquisition surveys of hotspots identified in the RI Report.
- Perform asbestos and lead survey/sample collection in Building 27.
- Begin removing contaminated Building 2 materials
- Complete mapping of exterior gamma walkover survey data and forward to the Navy.
- Prepare for soil removal in outside area adjacent to Building 27.
