US Navy Cleanup Project

This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

Summary of Activities:

- Continue reacquisition surveys of previously identified hotspots and step-out surveys on Building 27.
- Completed asbestos and lead sampling collection for Building 27.
- Completed in-coming surveys video inspection system (piping camera), boom lift, fork lift, 30Kv generator, and associated equipment.
- Completed weekly/monthly RMA boundary survey.
- Completed weekly Tisch air filter collection.

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Start removal and containerizing of ventilation system ducting in Building 2.
- Continue reacquisition survey of previously identified hotspots in Building 27.
- Containerize vegetation collected in outside area adjacent to Building 27.
- Complete mapping of exterior gamma walkover survey data and forward to the Navy.
- Plan for soil removal in outside area adjacent to Building 27 scheduled for September 23, 2013.
