**US Navy Cleanup Project**

This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

**Summary of Activities:**

- Completed initial reacquisition of previously identified hotspots and step-out surveys for inside of Building 27. Perform additional surveys as required.
- Started static surveys and swipe sample collection of ventilation system Building 2.
- Completed the removal, packaging and RMA storage of 197 linear feet of ducting from Building 2.
- Completed in-coming & out-going surveys of equipment.
- Completed weekly RMA boundary survey and weekly Tisch air filter collection.

**Activities Planned for Next Week:**

- Continue removal, packaging and RMA storage of ventilation system from Building 2.
- Continue static surveys/swipe sample collection of the ventilation system for Building 2.
- Complete containerization of vegetation collected in outside area adjacent to building 27.
- Complete mapping of exterior gamma walkover survey data and forward to the Navy.
- Complete gamma walkover surveys in outside area adjacent to Building 27. (Steel Plate Areas).
- Start soil removal in outside area adjacent to Building 27 (9/23, weather dependent).
