US Navy Cleanup Project

This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

The Navy's contractor will be working Monday through Thursday only.

Summary of Activities:

- Completed removal, packaging and RMA storage of 49 linear feet of ducting from building 2. Total ducting removed to date: 246 linear feet.
- Completed static surveys and swipe sample collection of air handler and ducting removal building 2.
- Completed removal, packaging and RMA storage of 39 square meters of contaminated flooring from second floor of building 2.
- Completed additional asbestos sample collection of roof, penthouse and second floor of building 27.
- Completed in-coming surveys of equipment.
- Completed weekly RMA boundary survey.
- Completed weekly Tisch air filter collection.

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Continue removal of contaminated flooring second floor building 2.
- Complete storage of vegetation collected in outside area adjacent to building 27. (9/23).
- Complete mapping of exterior gamma walkover survey data near building 27 and forward to the Navy.
- Complete gamma walkover surveys in outside area adjacent to Building 27. (Steel Plate Areas).
- Start soil removal in outside area adjacent to Building 27 (9/25, weather dependent).
