- Completed weekly RMA security survey (August 8).

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Continue soil characterization sampling of boring locations.
- Prep and ship soil characterization samples for off-site laboratory analysis.
- Complete reference (background) survey for multiple material types at building 47.
- Complete gamma walk-over surveys of fenced areas.
