COMFLEACT YOKOSUKA INSTRUCTION 5090.16

Subj: POLLUTION PREVENTION

Ref: (a) Commander, Fleet Activities, Yokosuka Pollution
Prevention Plan
(b) OPNAVINST 5090.1C

1. Purpose. To promulgate reference (a) to all personnel and commands within Commander, Fleet Activities (COMFLEACT), Yokosuka's Area of Responsibility (AOR).

2. Scope. Reference (a) integrates the requirements and information contained in Chapter 4 of reference (b) and provides cost effective strategies to reduce pollution generation at COMFLEACT, Yokosuka.

3. Applicability. The instruction applies to all commands, activities, and personnel working and living within the COMFLEACT, Yokosuka AOR.

4. Responsibilities

a. Pollution Prevention Manager

(1) Serve as each command's technical advisor on all issues regarding Pollution Prevention (P2).

(2) Manage the P2 Program; conduct oversight inspection of all departments, divisions, and tenant command operations to ensure that P2 policies are implemented.

(3) Develop and implement a facility P2 program that incorporates the Hazardous Material Control and Management requirement.

(4) Use the P2 Plan as a primary tool for identifying the methods and means to reduce pollution generation and to support cost effective, full and sustained compliance.

(5) Plan, program, budget, and allocate funds for all facility P2 projects identified in facility P2 Plans.

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b. Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Fleet Logistics Center (FLC) Yokosuka

(1) Implement Consolidated Hazardous Material Reutilization and Inventory Management System at COMFLEACT, Yokosuka, including establishing hazardous material minimization centers.

(2) Implement Hazardous Substance Management System/Hazardous Material Management System/Regional Hazardous Inventory Control System at COMFLEACT, Yokosuka including identifying a Material Safety Data Sheet, industrial type process, and waste stream for each manufacturer-specific hazardous material used within the facility.

c. Operations Personnel

(1) Comply with the policies and activities identified in the plan.

(2) Review work practices to identify potential changes in operations, methods, procedures or materials, which may be used to reduce the volume of pollutants generated.

(3) Fund, as appropriate, and implement P2 projects and procedures.
