# DIRECTIONS

## PEARL HARBOR

### From Nimitz Gate

Turn left on South Avenue. Follow South Avenue about 1/4 mile and turn right onto Russell Avenue. (This is the road heading to the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard). The Recycling Center (Bldg. 159) is about 1/4 mile on the right.

## HICKAM

### From Kuntz Gate

Make an immediate right after entering Kuntz Gate. Go to the third warehouse (Bldg. 1715) which is the Redemption Center & Recycling Center.

### From the Main Gate

Enter the main gate and go under the overpass. Move to the right lane and curve with the road following signs for Kuntz Gate. After driving past the overpass, stay on Kuntz Road as if you were planning on exiting Kuntz Gate. Just before the gate, turn left at the GSA building. Continue straight to the last, third, warehouse (Bldg. 1715). The Redemption Center is on one end of the building and the Recycling Center is on the other.

**H**I-5 bottles and cans can be redeemed at the Hickam Redemption Center using a voucher system. Vouchers will be issued to patrons that can be redeemed at the Hickam Bowling Alley.

*No money will be exchanged/provided  
by personnel at the Redemption Center.*

# RECYCLING IS EASY!

The Navy Region Hawaii Recycling Program has two convenient Recycling Center locations standing by to accept your recyclable goods. One on the Pearl Harbor-side (Bldg. 159) of Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) and the other on the Hickam-side (Bldg. 1715) which also has a **HI-5 Redemption Center**.

In addition to customers dropping off recyclables at the centers, other materials are picked up from pre-arranged points, including office areas, and/or collection bins, mini marts and piers throughout JBPHH.

Commands and activities interested in establishing regular pickup service for recyclables, or who need assistance in transporting large quantities of goods are encouraged to call the Navy Region Hawaii Recycling Program POC at 474-9207.

# ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

## OTHER

### Toner Cartridges

All laser toner cartridges including imaging units transfer rollers, fusers, etc.

*Note: Place used cartridges and items in the replacement box or in a separate plastic bag.*

### Untreated Wood Pallets

All wood should be dropped off at the Hickam Recycling Center location.

## PLASTIC/GLASS

### Glass Containers

All bottles and jars. Be sure to remove tops and rinse containers. No need to remove labels. Examples of accepted items include: glass containers, clear shrink wrap, all plastic grocery bags and plastics 1&2.

## METALS

All types of metals (ferrous and non-ferrous) are accepted. Metal cylinders need to be out-of-date, valve removed, and a hole drilled into the cylinder. Metals may only need to be dropped off during official times at the Pearl Harbor location.

## PAPER

### Cardboard

Pearl Harbor uses blue bins for cardboard collection and Hickam has cardboard trailers at various locations throughout the joint base.

*Note: All bags of shredded and regular paper, and large drop-offs of cardboard should be brought directly to the Hickam Recycling Center location during normal business hours. Be sure to flatten all boxes.*

### White Paper

All white paper including shredded. However no pulverized or cross cut paper will be accepted.

*Note: Shredded paper needs to be placed in a clear plastic bag and taken to the Hickam Recycling Center or left inside a designated blue bin.*

### Magazines

Books (hard and soft cover), magazines, catalogs, and other non-white paper may be mixed together.

*Note: Newspapers should be kept separate.*
