⇒**Central Contractor Registration (CCR):** CCR is a nationwide electronic database of firms that do business with the Department of Defense. Any firm interested in doing business with DOD must be CCR registered. <https://www.sam.gov/index.html>

⇒**Online Representations and Certifications (ORCA):** ORCA is an e-Government initiative designed to replace the paper based Representations and Certifications (Reps and Certs) process. <https://www.sam.gov/index.html>

⇒**Federal Business Opportunities (FedBizOpps):**

The U. S. Government's one-stop virtual marketplace. Through this single point-of-entry, commercial vendors and government buyers are invited to post, search, monitor, and retrieve opportunities solicited by the entire Federal contracting community. www.fbo.gov

⇒**Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO):** The Navy's solicitations and procurement related information. Vendors interested in doing business with the Naval Facilities Engineering Command or the Navy will find procurement opportunities that exceed \$25,000.

⇒**Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS):** CPARS is a web-enabled application that collects and manages the library of automated CPARS. CPARS is for UNCLASSIFIED use only. Classified information is not to be entered into this system. A CPARS assesses a contractor's performance and provides a record, both positive and negative, on a given contractor during a specific period of time.
