

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q What is the cost to attend this seminar?

A There is no cost to attend.

Q Does RITS training count towards Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) Continuous Learning Credit?

A Yes, attending a full day of RITS counts as 8 Continuous Learning Credits (CLC) for DAWIA. You will get a certificate of attendance at the end of the seminar.

Q Do I need to submit an SF-182 form?

A Typically, you do not need a Standard Form (SF) 182 Authorization, Agreement and Certification of Training, however, follow the guidance at your Facilities Engineering Command (FEC).

Q Can contractors attend RITS?

A Contractor attendance is limited to contractors with a current, active Navy Environmental Restoration contract.

Q How can I suggest content for future seminars?

A Simply list your suggestions for future seminar topics on the Evaluation Form that is included in your Student Handbook. Or submit via email to EXWC_RITS@navy.mil.

Q Are there Base Access/Security requirements at the RITS facility?

A Yes. The requirements are different for each location, so be sure to read and comply with the specific requirements for the location you plan to attend.

Q Can someone else attend in my place?

A No. Only those who have completed the Registration/Security process and are on the Base Access List can attend, unless they have other means of access via a Common Access Card (CAC) or RapidGate Pass.
