As discussed during our January 13, 1995 meeting with James Szykman and Art Wells of Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (LANTDIV), and Sindulfo Castillo of NAVSTA Roosevelt Roads Public Works Office, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region II has determined that, pursuant to the November 28, 1994 RCRA/HSWA Permit (the Permit), the Pre-Investigation Corrective Measures Study Report (PICMSR) submitted on behalf of Roosevelt Roads fulfills the requirements of Task I (Description of Current Conditions) and Task II (Pre-Investigation Evaluation of Corrective Measures Technologies) of the RCRA Facilities Investigation (RFI) Statement of Work (SOW) incorporated into the Permit.

Also, as discussed during the January 13, 1995 meeting, complete RFI work plans (Task III of the SOW), reflective of EPA comments on the PICMSR, given in my letter of December 19, 1994, as clarified during the January 13 meeting, are due March 28, 1995 for all SWMUs/AOCs pursuant to the corrective action requirements of the Permit.

The minutes from the January 13, 1995 meeting are enclosed.
