Baker Environmental, Inc., (Baker) is prepared to conduct the site inspection and file review for the Naval Ammunition Facility on Vieques Island (NAF-Vieques), supporting completion of the Hazard Ranking System (HRS) calculation for that facility. This inspection will include Sites 1, 2 and 3 of the IRP associated with CTO-0007.

As agreed during our conversations of the week of July 6, 1992, the inspection team during the week of July 13 will include the following personnel presently assigned to CTO-0007: Mr. John Barone, Project Manager; Mr. Donald Shields, Project Geologist; Ms. Melissa Davidson, Community Relations Specialist; and Ms. Susan Johnston, Environmental Scientist (and a specialist in site evaluations). Ms. Davidson and Ms. Johnston both also have technical assignments during the field investigations and analysis of data for the IRP sites of CTO-0007. Ms. Johnston has specific responsibility for the Site Inspection and preparation of the support for the Hazard Ranking System (HRS) for NAF-Vieques. The other personnel are concerned primarily with the Technical Review Committee (TRC) presentation, also held during the week of July 13; their involvement with the inspection at NAF-Vieques will be to a lesser extent and will depend on needs identified by Ms. Johnston during her review.

The field inspection of NAF-Vieques is presently expected to occur on July 16. File research and additional work are intended for July 17 and, if necessary, July 20 and 21; if the inspection is extended to the latter dates, we expect that Ms. Johnston will conduct the file research and additional work, assisted if and as required by Mr. Barone. The scheduled submission of the draft inspection report to LANTDIV-EIC is

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July 24, with comments returned on or about July 31 and the final version of the inspection report due to LANTDIV on August 10, 1992.

We will present the details of our planning and the expected form of the reporting for the site inspection to your representatives at the preparation on July 14 for the TRC meeting.
