Subject: CONFERENCE CALL #2 BETWEEN NAVY & GRUMMAN

1. John Ohlmann initiated the conference call as per our agreement during the last conference call on 3/29/93, in order to keep both parties informed as to each other's planned activities.
2. John informed us that the sampling has been done for the new polishing pond. The results are expected shortly and Grumman agreed to let us take a look at the results. The plastic tanks that are on the polishing pond site are not completely empty yet. However, since groundbreaking isn't anticipated for another 3 months, they are not in the way.
3. John wanted to see us to analyze another soil gas point during our Phase 2 Soil Gas program using a Field GC, bringing the total to ten. We concurred.
4. Grumman/G&M comments on the initial chapters of the FS will be FedExed today.
5. G&M wants to do another round of water level measurements on 4/30/93. They have tentatively identified the downgradient edge of the plume as being about 1,000 feet north of BWD's Plant #4.
6. I asked John Ohlmann if he had any knowledge of a Grumman representative going to a neighborhood meeting in the local community to discuss the NYSDEC information sheet. John said that to his knowledge, no one from Grumman was sent. He went on to say that a Grumman worker who lives in that neighborhood could have gone in which case John probably wouldn't know about it.
7. The next conference call was set up for 7 June 1993, at 1000.
