RE: INSTALLATION RESTORATION (IR) STUDY AT NAVAL AIR STATION, BRUNSWICK, ME

Dear Mr. Wardwell:

The meeting on 12 June 1987 at the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region I offices, concerning the Installation Restoration (IR) study at the Naval Air Station (NAS) Brunswick, ME, allowed the Navy and E. C. Jordan to learn the regulatory agencies concerns. EPA Region I, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and State of Maine Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) personnel provided comments for consideration in the next step of the NAS Brunswick IR study.

Because of the amount of discussion concerning the field work to be included in the next step, it is important for the Navy and E. C. Jordan to agree on the field work to be conducted. This Command has prepared a summary of field work discussed at the 12 June 1987 meeting, which is in addition to the field work developed in the plan of action finalized in October 1986. This Command requests E. C. Jordan review and verify the additional field work summary based on E. C. Jordan's understanding of the regulatory agencies concerns and discussion at the 12 June 1987 meeting. A prompt response to this letter is requested.

After the Navy and E. C. Jordan agree on the field work to be conducted, this Command will proceed with contract amendment procedures.
