

Dear Mr. Springfield:

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MEDEP) forwarded comments on the Draft Additional Sampling Plan, R1/FS Program for the Brunswick Naval Air Station on May 22, 1989 and approved the document as 6/15/89.

The contractor, E.C. Jordan, responded to these comments at a meeting of the Technical Review Committee (TRC) on June 20, 1989.

After E.C. Jordan presented their response to agency comments Mr. Rick Berringer of Northern Division provided the Navy's comments which consisted of elimination of proposed work or delays in monitoring well installation. Both EPA and DEP informed the Navy that any proposed changes and the rationale for these changes were to be submitted in writing for agency review and approval. MEDEP expressed concern that the delay in beginning field work would set back the schedule.

The MEDEP was surprised to note that the agency response and request for written revisions were not included in the written 6-20-89 TRC meeting minutes distributed at the August 10 TRC meeting. The minutes simply stated that the Navy would distributed a revised Additional Sampling Plan.

The MEDEP received a document entitled Additional Sampling Plan on 8/10/89, and assumes this is the revised plan alluded to in the 6-20-89 meeting minutes. The MEDEP does not consider this work plan approved until the MEDEP has provided comments and they are addressed.
