Dear Mr. and Mrs. Coffin:

As part of the ongoing cleanup of the Naval Air Station Brunswick, a sample of your well water was taken from your home on February 23, 2006 by the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). This water sample was analyzed at the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Laboratory in Chelmsford, Massachusetts for volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and for the chemical 1,4 dioxane. ***No VOCs and no 1,4 dioxane were detected in your well water.*** I have enclosed a copy of the results for your well.

The Navy will continue the cleanup process at the base and both the EPA and the DEP will continue to review the potability of your private water supply.
