Dear Mr. Monaco:

Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MEDEP) has reviewed the June 12-14 2007 Technical Meeting Notes, received via email July 17, 2007, prepared by Environmental Chemical Corporation. Based on that review MEDEP has the following additions and revisions.

June 12, Item 4, Sites 15 and 16:

"It is located next to a cemetery in the northwestern corner (dog training area) and near the commanders [*sic*] house."

This information is confused with Site 16. Please revise as follows and put this sentence and the next two at the end of the paragraph. "*Other locations where debris was found during the CERFA walkover were northwestern corner of the base boundary near the cemetery and the former dog training area and the activity reported soil piles behind the Commander's house.*"

"The debris observations were in the area where concrete debris was seen ..."

This is Site 15 and drum remnants were found near the impoundment and at the survival training area. Please revise.

Item 6, Quarry Site:

It was noted in the meeting that the Quarry Site has the potential for dumping of other debris and materials.
